

# Use Local Administrator Rights for Windows



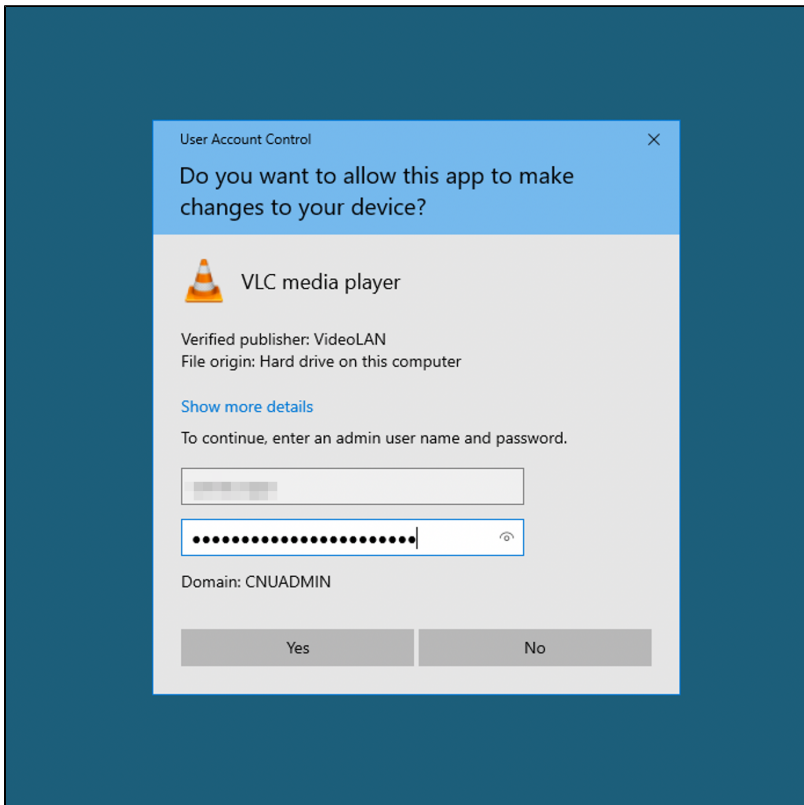
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When installing software or updates, sometimes you will see a UAC (User Account Control) prompt. If you have been granted Local Admin Rights via approval from your VP and the CNU Information Technology Services ISO (Information Security Officer). Then the following will apply:

To utilize the Local Admin rights associated with your Windows machine, you must do the following:

- After clicking the software that you wish to install you will be prompted with the following UAC.



- Click **Yes**.
- Your software will proceed as intended, allowing changes to be made associated with the Local Admin account created in a former Help Desk ticket.
