Respondus Lockdown Browser/Respondus Monitor Overview

Respondus Lockdown Browser

- The Respondus Lockdown browser is an internet browser set to access Scholar, and only Scholar, while locking down any other program open on the computer.
- It also locks down the ability to perform actions in Scholar other than taking a Respondus-enabled test.
- While using the Lockdown browser to take a test, students will not be able to use other programs on their computer or even access other
 websites, protecting the security of that test attempt.
- Students will need to download and install the Lockdown Browser on their computers, if they intend to use their own computer to take exams that

Respondus Monitor

- Monitor works to protect the security of an exam from external concerns.
- Uses the web camera and microphone in a student computer to verify the identity of a student taking an exam, then record their test-taking attempt remotely.
- It flags potential issues in that attempt, such as a student leaving the view of the camera or taking out an external device like a phone, in a report
 that instructors can then review for themselves.
- · Instructors cannot activate Respondus Monitor without first enabling the Respondus Lockdown Browser requirement.
